Your first Day Services appointment usually takes around two hours where we work in partnership with you to develop a plan that will help towards meeting your goals.

Our specialist Tresillian Nurses and in some cases, an Aboriginal Health Worker, work alongside your Child and Family Health Service. They can help make sense of your child's crying, sleep, advise on breastfeeding, bottle-feeding, nutrition and toddler behaviour and your own emotional well-being, giving you confidence and reassurance.

Virtual Consultations

If you find it's difficult to visit Tresillian in Murrumbidgee due to distance or other challenges, we can arrange a Virtual Appointment with a Tresillian Nurse, via video-link, using your mobile phone or other device.
